Section 1: General Rules and Regulations

- 1) **Proof of insurance is mandatory** at every show in order to show or ride horses while on show grounds. For Island competitors this must be paid through Island Horse Council and is \$40.00 for the year for each individual. Out-of-Province Competitors must show proof of liability insurance from their own provincial board (ie. NSEF or NBEA).
- 2) Show participants must be current members of the IRHA. Membership fee is **\$10/person** or **\$15/family**. A form is included in the show book and can be found on the website.
- 3) It is the responsibility of each competitor to ensure that they enter only classes which they are eligible for.
- 4) Full payment must accompany entry forms. If no money is received with the form, no entry is confirmed. Please refer to the individual show forms for applicable post entry dates and fees. Penalty post entry fee of **\$20.00** will be charged for late entries.
- 5) A **\$15.00 horse fee** will be charged for all horses not competing but using the show grounds. We ask that you register with the show secretary.
- 6) Refunds on entry fees can be requested up until the day of the show, however stall fees are non-refundable at all times. There will be no refunds on the day of or after the show.
- 7) During an IRHA sanctioned event or show, any exhibitor may be disqualified (for the entire show) by any IRHA official acting under the Judges authority if the said exhibitor displays abusive behavior towards a horse, the Judge, or any IRHA official. Use of excessive force on a horse can, and will, be used as grounds for dismissal (ie. excessive spurring, whipping etc). All equipment must be non-abusive and humane.
- 8) In the event of a tie, the next placing will not be awarded. For example, if there is a tie for second place, there will not be a third place awarded. The prize money for the tied placings will be added with the next placing and split.
- 9) NRHA patterns will be used in all classes. Pattern selections are documented on entries. Patterns can be found at <https://nrha.com/media/pdf/handbook/2019/handbook.pdf>
- 10) All patterns will be scored based on NRHA rules and regulations. See <https://nrha.com/media/pdf/handbook/2019/handbook.pdf>
- 11) A score of '0' or 'No Score' is not eligible for placing as per NRHA Rules and Regulations. eg. If a rider goes off pattern.
- 12) No contestant may address the Judge without the approval of the Ring Steward.
- 13) A rider can ride a maximum of three (3) horses of any gender in a class.
- 14) All horses entered in a class must be assembled in ample time to allow the class to continue without delay. A contestant will have thirty (30) seconds to make his/her way to the ring after their number is called. Failure to do so will result in elimination. The decision of the person calling the

numbers is final.

- 15) All entries must be run as drawn. If a rider has two (2) horses in one event, the rider will be allowed a spacing of at least two (2) horses between his/her mounts when possible and when there are enough entries in that particular class.
- 16) Riders must make a point of being dressed neatly and cleanly. Appropriate western attire is required which includes pants (slacks, trousers, jeans), western hat or helmet, and boots. Shirts must have long sleeves. The hat or helmet must be on the rider's head when the exhibitor enters the arena. Chaps are optional. Should proper dress not be adhered to the Judge may have due cause to disqualify the entry.
- 17) Horses will be shown with proper western saddle and bridle. A saddle pad is mandatory. Equipment must be neat and well kept.
- 18) Chain curb straps must be flat and allow two fingers between the horse's jaw and the strap.
- 19) The use of a rawhide braided, leather braided, or rope bosal is allowed on junior horses (6 and under) in all classes. On aged horses it is only allowed in Green as Grass pending judges approval.
- 20) All Youth riders competing must wear CSA approved headgear in competition and on the show grounds at all times when mounted.
- 21) While in the ring all riders will pass left to left.
- 22) Freestyle Reining required maneuvers will be defined as follows:
 - 1) A minimum of four (4) consecutive spins to the right
 - 2) A minimum of four (4) consecutive spins to the left
 - 3) A minimum of three (3) stops
 - 4) A minimum of one (1) lead change at the canter from right to left
 - 5) A minimum of one (1) lead change at the canter from left to right
 - 6) Additional maneuvers such as rollbacks, backups, speed variations, and non-classical reining maneuvers such as half pass and side pass are appropriate in Freestyle and shall be given appropriate credit. Additional repetitions of required maneuvers are appropriate, but will only add or subtract from the existing scores already given for the required maneuvers, not as additional scores.

- 23) For events at the Crapaud Agriplex:
 - 1) Please send stall fees in with your entry forms.
 - 2) Tying to your trailer is not permitted on the show grounds due to liability reasons. A stall must be rented for events at this location by all participants.
 - 3) Please completely clean out your stall and sweep surrounding area prior to leaving the show grounds.
 - 4) Riders are not permitted to sit on or ride a horse in the barn.

Section 2: Divisions

Green as Grass

This class is for horse and rider combinations that are new to the sport of reining. This pattern does not require any lead changes. Any legal bit may be used. One or two hands may be used on the reins. Neither horse nor rider can have lifetime earnings of more than \$150 in total from any reining competitions.

Green Rider

This class is for riders that have lifetime earnings of less than \$500 in total from any reining competitions. One or two hands may be used on the reins. Any legal bit may be used.

Novice Horse

This class is for horses that have lifetime earnings of less than \$1500 in total from any reining competitions. One or two hands may be used on the reins. Any legal bit may be used.

Novice Rider - *Global Pet Foods*

This class is for riders that have lifetime earnings of less than \$1500 in any reining competitions. One or two hands may be used on the reins. Any legal bit may be used.

Junior Horse

This class is for horses 6 years of age and under. One or two hands may be used on the reins. Any legal bit may be used.

Youth Short Stirrup

This class is for riders that are 18 years of age and under as of January 1 who are in their first two (2) years of reining competition. One or two hands may be used on the reins. Any legal bit may be used. Only Short Stirrup pattern A or B will be used.

Youth - "Horseman's Legacy"

This class is for riders that are 18 years of age and under as of January 1. One or two hands may be used on the reins. Any legal bit may be used.

Non Pro

This class is for riders that do not train or teach for profit. Only one hand is to be used on the reins. Any legal bit may be used.

Open

This class is for horse and rider combinations that have been exposed to reining. Only one hand is to be used on the reins. Any legal bit may be used.

Freestyle

This class is for horse and rider combinations that have been exposed to reining. Any legal bit may be used. Exhibitors will be judged by the crowd. Time Limit: maximum four (4) minutes. Music must be submitted before classes begin for the day. See General Rule #21

Section 3: IRHA Point System

Year end points will be taken from the best 3 out of 4 shows. Highpoint and reserve awards will be given for 9 divisions.
