CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:

Open

This class is for rider combinations that have been exposed to reining. Only one hand is to be used on the reins. Any legal bit may be used.

Green Rider

This class is for riders that have not yet earned any more than \$100 in total from any reining competitions. One or two hands may be used on the reins. Any legal bit may be used.

Junior Horse

This class is for horses 6 years of age and under. One or two hands may be used on the reins. Any legal bit may be used.

Green as grass

This class is for riders and horse combinations that are new to the sport of reining. This pattern does not require any lead changes. Any legal bit may be used. One or two hands may be used on the reins. Neither horse nor rider could have earned more than \$50 in total from any reining competitions. Rider must be in their first or second consecutive year of showing reining. Rider may not have won a first place year-end award from any organization for reining.

Novice Horse

This class is for horses that have not yet earned any more than \$100 in total from any reining competitions. One or two hands may be used on the reins. Any legal bit may be used.

Youth Reining

This class is for riders that are 17 years of age and under as of January 1, 2012. This pattern does not require any lead changes. One or two hands may be used on the reins. Any legal bit may be used.

Non Pro Reining

This class is not for riders that train or teach for profit. Only one hand is to be used on the reins. Any legal bit may be used.

Novice Rider

This class is for riders that have lifetime earnings of less than \$250 in any reining competitions. One or two hands may be used on the reins. Any legal bit may be used.
